This is an adventure trip to the tip of Australia for all ages, a trip taking in amazing sights and amazing people. You will travel in total comfort all the time, campfire magic and a good glass of wine, the problems of the world just seem to fade away...

Early mornings begin with a slow awakening, the birds calling and the smell of the camp fire with fresh coffee brewing, the sun creeps over the horizon, another day dawns. Another waterfall or a private beach on aboriginal lands awaits, maybe a walk along the beach or a quick swim before breakfast.

The days are fairly full on, after all we have a lot to accomplish and quite a few kilometres to travel, Port Douglas, Daintree, Princess Charlotte Bay, Coen, Weipa, Cooktown, Archer River, Bamaga, The Telegraph Station, Thursday Island, Captain Billy's landing, lots to see and lots to do.

This is wilderness at its very best, where cattle stations, mining and aboriginal lands collide, covering the wild rivers preservation area and the Daintree world heritage, the list of stunning places to see and visit in this region is mind boggling, the birdlife, reptiles and wildlife abound. Beautiful water falls on Billabongs were big old crocodiles lie in

the sun. The top end is a place of amazing scenery with mysteries and stories that will captivate all who are fortunate enough to visit this ancient land.



We will be travelling in the latest model Toyota Land Cruiser wagons, providing luxury and comfort the whole way. Generally sleeping will be in tents, although there are a few nights during our 12 day schedule where we will be staying in cabins tucked away in the jungle. The food will be first rate and plenty of it, mostly camp fire cooking but also some restaurant and pub meals along the way.

Your crew are there to look after you, they are the best around and have spent many years travelling, working and living in this land so by the time you finish the trip you will not only understand a lot about Cape York, but will also have picked up some bush skills and the odd story to tell, or is that maybe not to tell

Whilst we have set schedules, there is also the opportunity to arrange side trips; fishing, helicopter flights, golf, and bushwalks. The journey takes 12 days of steady going finishing with a flight to Cairns from Bamaga, taking in the spectacular scenery, this time from the air, what a nice way to finish.

The departure date from Bamaga can be extended if required given sufficient notice to re-arrange flights.

The whole trip is a very laid back affair, we are not in a hurry, we are all here to enjoy the journey and have a great time, tell yarns and soak up atmosphere. Showering and proper toilets will be available every day with washing machines for clothes on several days throughout the trip.

What to bring.

Your very own personal good sleeping bag or blanket, we supply pillows mattress and fresh linen.

Hat, sunglasses and sunscreens.

Your own personal toiletry bag with all necessary medicines and extra little bits that are needed.

Clothes are really your choice, we do have a reasonable amount of room, but in saying that you don't need a lot. The temperature is going to be very mild with the emphasis on casual and relaxed look.

Suggested clothes list:

Swimmers, 2 pairs of shorts , 2 long pants and a half dozen cotton, long and short sleeve shirts and you're done, you can bring more if you like though

Couple of scarves are handy sometimes and a pair of gloves never goes astray.

A warm coat just in case, anything is possible.

Sandshoes, thongs ..socks, jocks and pyjamas if necessary

All purpose knife and a slip on head light for around the camp at night

Insect repellent, we will have some but sometimes your own personal supply is handy.

Towel and some sort of flannel, maybe small squeeze soap.

If you don't have a head lamp bring a good torch with spare battery's.

Bring a camera and spare batteries or a charger.

Cameras and battery operated devices are easy to charge.

A fly net is good to have.

If you do a bit of walking sometimes a camelback can be very good and a small day knapsack.
